Biosketch

Jan M. Stratil is a Senior Scientist at the Institute of Public Health, Medical Decision Making and Health Technology Assessment at UMIT TIROL - University for Health Sciences and Health Technology in Hall in Tirol, Austria.

Jan studied Medicine (Federal Examination) and Geography (Bachelor of Science) at the University of Tübingen, Germany, where he also completed his Medical Doctorate in the field of Health Services Research. Afterwards, we worked in the Working Group of Evidence-based Public Health at the Ludwig-Maximilians University Munich, where he also completed his PhD in Public Health and Epidemiology with a focus on guideline development for complex public health interventions. Since 2021, he has worked at the Robert Koch-Institute in Berlin in the field of infectious-disease epidemiology and completed the German field epidemiology training program.

At the Institute, Jan works in the EU Horizon 2020 projects CATALYSE and PARC and teaches in the MPH and the doctoral program at UMIT TIROL. He is also involved in the mentoring of master students and junior scientists.

Jan's current substantive research focuses lies on the impact of climate change on health as well as on SARS-CoV-2, with a particular interest in vulnerable populations such as residents of long-term care facilities. Further research interests are evidence-based public health including the assessment of adverse and unintended consequences of public health interventions, systematic reviews, and guideline development for complex public health interventions, in particular the evidence-to-decision process.
